## ITINERARY

Two Hearts, One Purpose - A Maasai safari Journey





## 7 Days / 6 Nights PACKAGE EXPERIENCE

### Day 1 - Arrival & Eco-Lodge Welcome

Arrival at Kilimanjaro International Airport (KIA). Private transfer to the Maasai Eco-Lodge. Check-in, welcome refreshments and lodge orientation. Afternoon at leisure to relax and enjoy the natural surroundings. Overnight at the Eco-Lodge.

### Day 2 - Community Engagement & Connection

Breakfast at the lodge. Visit to the Maasai Girls Rescue Centre. Spend meaningful time with the girls through storytelling, games and cultural exchange. Identify the girls who will join the safari experience. Return to the lodge. Overnight at the Eco-Lodge.

### Day 3 - Ngorongoro Crater Safari

Early breakfast followed by a full-day safari at Ngorongoro Crater with the selected girls. Enjoy wildlife viewing and a picnic lunch inside the crater. Late afternoon return to the lodge. Overnight at the Eco-Lodge.

### Day 4 - Tarangire National Park Safari

Breakfast at the lodge. Full-day safari at Tarangire National Park, famous for large elephant herds and baobab trees. Picnic lunch during the game drive. Return to the lodge in the evening. Overnight at the Eco-Lodge.

## DAY 5 - Lake Manyara & Leisure Afternoon

Breakfast at the lodge. Half-day safari at Lake Manyara National Park. Return to the lodge for an afternoon at leisure. Optional spa time or nature walks. Overnight at the Eco-Lodge.

## DAY 6 - Monduli Cultural Experience

Breakfast and check-out. Travel to Monduli for an authentic Maasai cultural experience. Spend time with Maasai women learning about traditions, beading and daily life. Dinner under the stars. Overnight at a traditional Maasai Manyatta.

## DAY 7 - Departure

Morning at leisure with Maasai women. Farewell and reflections. Transfer to Arusha Airport for a flight to Zanzibar for relaxation or transfer to Kilimanjaro International Airport for international departure.

### Inclusion:

- 5 nights accommodation at the Maasai Eco-Lodge (Days 1-5) and 1 night at a traditional Maasai Manyatta in Monduli (Day 6)
- Full Board at the Eco-Lodge (Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)
- All meals during the Manyatta stay
- Private Van airport transfers:
  - Pick-up from Kilimanjaro International Airport (KIA)
  - Drop-off at Arusha Airport or KIA (as per itinerary)
- Private 4x4 safari vehicle with pop-up roof for Safari
- Professional English-speaking driver-guide
- Full-day Ngorongoro Crater safari (with selected Maasai girls)
- Full-day Tarangire National Park safari (with selected Maasai girls)
- Half-day Lake Manyara National Park safari (with selected Maasai girls)
- All park entrance fees & conservation fees
- Ngorongoro Crater Service Fee
- Guided visit to the Maasai Girls Rescue Centre
- Curated interaction & activities with the girls
- Coordination and supervision of selected girls joining the safaris
- Monduli Maasai cultural experience, including:
  - Time with Maasai women (beading, storytelling, daily life)
  - Traditional welcome and farewell ceremony
  - Community contribution to the Rescue Centre & Manyatta community
  - On-ground experience coordinator
